Be Well Kenmore

This committee is concerned with the health of the Kenmore community in all its forms—mental, emotional, spiritual, and physical. The group works to help area residents learn about the many health-related opportunities available here while developing and presenting additional programs that will assist each person in obtaining and strengthening their good health.
